

What is the purpose of this document?

Elementary Business Consultancy ("we", "us", "our"), are committed to protecting your privacy and complying with our data protection obligations under the Data Protection Act 2018 (the DPA 2018), the UK General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (the UK GDPR) and any other applicable UK legislation (together, Data Protection Law).

This privacy notice describes how we collect and use personal information about you during and after your working relationship with us, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

7. How do we use your data?

- 7.1 All personal data is processed and stored securely, for no longer than is necessary in light of the reason(s) for which it was first collected. We will comply with our obligations and safeguard your rights under the GDPR at all times.
- our use of your personal data will always have a lawful basis, either because it is necessary for our performance of a contract with you, because you have consented to our use of your personal data (e.g. by subscribing to emails), or because it is in our legitimate interests. Specifically, we may use your data for the following purposes:
 - 7.2.1 Providing and managing your account with Elementary Business Consultancy
 - 7.2.2 Supplying our products and / or services to you (please note that we require your personal data in order to enter into a contract with you)
 - 7.2.3 Personalising and tailoring our products and / or services for you
 - 7.2.4 Replying to emails from you

 - 7.2.6 Market research

- 7.4 You have the right to withdraw your consent to us using your personal data at any time, and to request that we delete it.

8. How and where do we store your data?

- 8.1 We only keep your personal data for as long as we need to, are legally entitled to and/or for as long as we have your permission to keep it.
- 8.2 Your data will only be stored within the European Economic Area ("the EEA").
- 8.3 Data security is very important to us, and to protect your data we have taken suitable measures to safeguard and secure data.

9. Do we share your data?

9.1 Subject to section 8.2, We will not share any of your data with any third parties for any purposes without your permission. We may ask your permission to share data with third party contractors and / or suppliers in relation to any contract we have with you.



9.2 In certain circumstances, we may be legally required to share certain data held by us, which may include your personal data, for example, where We are involved in legal proceedings, where We are complying with legal obligations, a court order, or a governmental authority.

10. How can you control your data?

When you submit personal data to us, you may be given options to restrict our use of your data. In 10.1 particular, we aim to give you strong controls on our use of your data for direct marketing purposes (including the ability to opt-out of receiving emails from us which you may do by unsubscribing using the links provided in our emails and at the point of providing your details.
